This campaign includes a complete renovation of the Holy Name Alumni Field House; including adding heating and air conditioning and converting the large locker room into a kitchen so that not only sporting events but other community activities and celebrations can be hosted.

A new Community Center will be built which will link the Field House and the School. The Community Center will have conference rooms and other amenities. The Center will facilitate a new entrance to the School so that parents can safely drop off and pick up their children and an elevator in the School building!

For the last couple of years, Holy Name School has been piloting an "after school" program in affiliation with the HOPE Center for Kids. With the renovated Field House and the new Community Center a comprehensive after school program can be implemented and serve our children and the children of the surrounding community.

The past is so important to our future! Two strong Holy Name families have provided strength and support for this project. The field house will be named for legendary athlete and coach, Bob Gates and the community center will be named for Stephen F Dwyer.

The Holy Name Alumni Field House was constructed in 1949. During these past seventy years, thousands of children have learned, played and competed within its walls. It stands today as a testament to those who came before and their dedication to the neighborhood, the community and most importantly to the children. The Field House is structurally sound; but needs a complete renovation to achieve these goals.

In 2018 Holy Name Parish and Holy Name School celebrated 100 years of service to this community. **Restore the Glory** is not just about buildings.
