Our Work Continues! Over the summer some preliminary tasks were completed. Working with the CUES Building and Grounds committee a company was hired to do some excavation on the east side of the school building to assess and alleviate water drainage issues that have plagued that side of the building for years. Work was done on the drainage and the excavated area was treated and refilled. We also hired a Survey Team to begin the site planning for the project. The site plan is complete and work will begin to bring groups of folks together to view the drawings and add necessary input so that the plans encompass the most critical needs for the community.

The Goal: Phase I (\$3.37MM) is a complete renovation of the original structure and a new addition connecting the field house to the school. The field house will be available for physical education, athletics, parish, school and community activities. **Phase II (\$1.63MM)** will provide an investment of \$1MM for continued maintenance of the newly renovated building and utilize the space in the new addition for after school programming.


