In late February, a group of more than 30 stakeholders for the Restore the Glory Capital Campaign for the Holy Name Alumni Field House came together to align the planning goals for this project. It takes time to raise the funds for a dream to become a reality. We are getting close enough with our fundraising to make sure that we have solid plans in place. With this in mind the group spent time brainstorming goals for the project. These goals match up perfectly to the dream that began a little over four years ago. Some of the goals for the renovation from stakeholders included: handicapped accessibility, updated gym floor, room to serve the children in extended learning programs, serve the neighborhood and Holy Name, modernize the building, including lighting and security, restrooms, update indoor and outdoor athletic and play areas providing space for more than one activity to happen simultaneously, provide an activity room and make the building technology friendly. Everyone is so excited to finally see the light in the tunnel for the second coming of the Holy Name Alumni Field House. Hope at Holy Name School!

Holy Name School began a partnership with the Hope Center for Kids in 2018. This partnership created a pilot after school program for 30-35 students.



The programming focused on the necessary structure and support needed during out of school time hours. The pilot program is growing! These children need the added space provided by the renovation of the Field House. Once renovations are complete expanded programming will be available to serve as many as 250 youth from this community in North Omaha.





Anticipated Outcome | Impact to the Community

With the renovation and new construction the Restore the Glory Campaign will:

- Provide a **safe environment** for all users of the facilities.
- Greatly expand the **sports opportunities** for the community at-large.
- Allow the community at-large to have access to the **multi-use spaces**.
- Facilitate **extended learning opportunities** to 150-350 students daily.

PROJECT BUDGET

Phase I Renovation & Construction

Renovation of the Field House \$1,120,000

Construction of enhanced

Community space/Connector \$1,674,000 Site Preparation & Contingency \$576,000

Total budget to complete Phase I \$3,370,000

Phase II Programming & Maintenance

Provides continuous staffing, maintenance and programming for the sports complex and community spaces and implementation of year-round quality Extended Learning (Afterschool) Programs for elementary, middle, and high school students with emphasis on Science, Technology, Engineerly, Arts, and Mathematics (STEAM) learning opportunities.

Programming \$ 630,000 Invested Reserve Fund \$ 1,000,000

Total budget to complete Phase II

\$ 1,630,000
