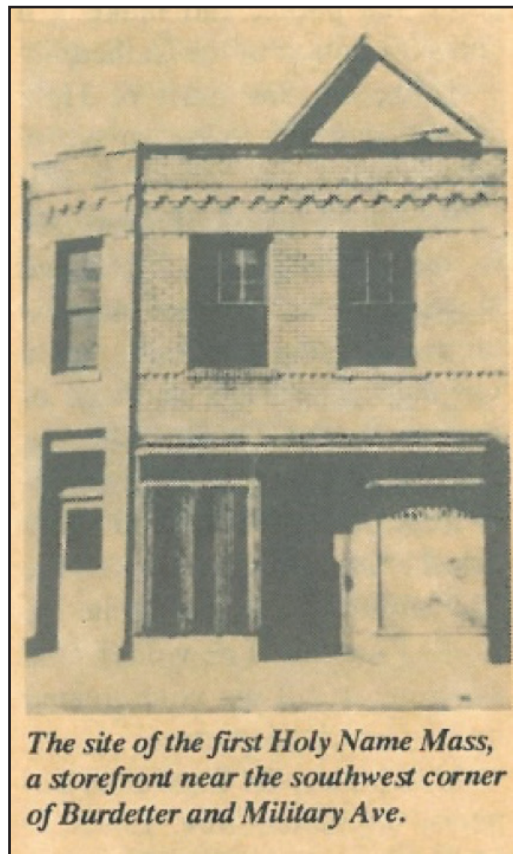

Holy Name is very close to celebrating a major milestone. Both the parish and the school will celebrate 100 years of pastoral care for the faithful of our church and educational excellence for thousands of students. The school celebrations will begin with Alumni weekend in June of 2018. A tentative date has been set with the Archbishop to celebrate an All School Mass on Wednesday, August 29th, 2018.

Over the next eighteen months planning will take place for many joyous activities for the school and the parish. The staff of the alumni and development office will be working with the Servants of Mary to make the milestone year a great celebration for each and every one of us. There are many ways you can help support this achievement!

“The only available site Rev. Stephen L. Dowd (first Archdiocesan Pastor) could find was an old, weather-beaten store, near the southwest corner of Military and Burdette Streets, which had previously been used as an automobile repair shop. It was home to the first Mass offered at Holy Name Parish on August 12, 1917 and was used for the next three Sundays.”

From that August day on, there was a flurry of activity including the purchase of land and the setting of plans for a permanent church building to serve the community.

Dear Holy Name Families and Friends,

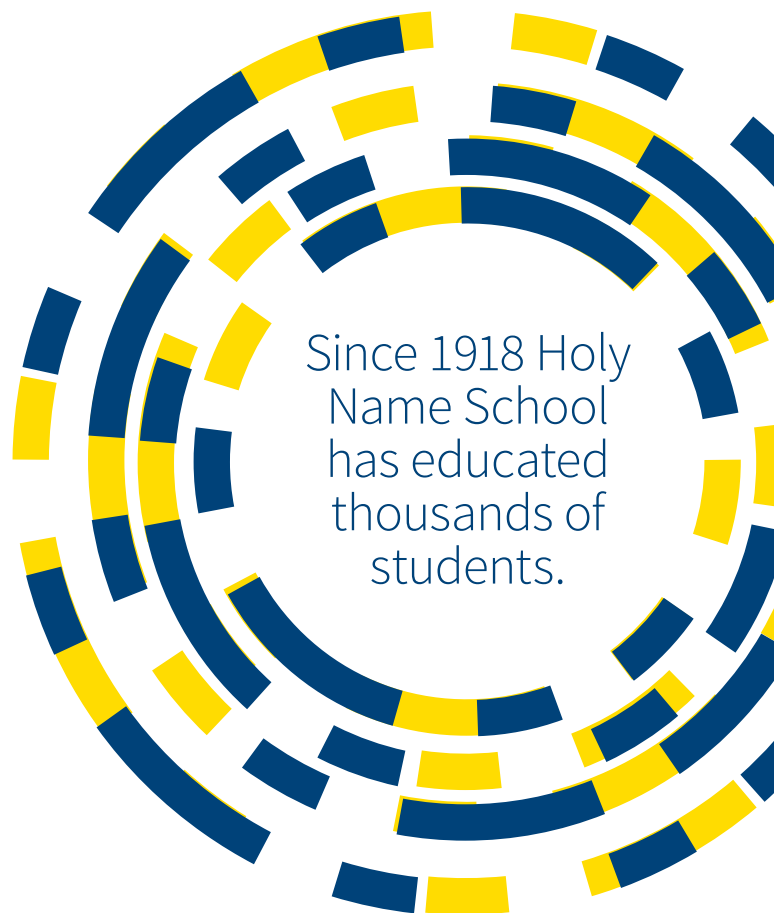

HOLY NAME HISTORY

This time of planning occurred during the beginning of World War I, and Fr. Dowd saw that his services were greatly needed as a chaplain in the Army. The Omaha Archdiocese was experiencing a shortage of priests and reached out to the Redemptorist community to fill the Pastor position for Holy Name. On June 23, 1918, Rev. Louis P. McKeown answered the call along with Rev. Frederick J. Urbanus. As well as building a permanent church and rectory, the Redemptorists were committed to opening a school. Fr. McKeown had a relationship with the Servants of Mary and solicited their service to open a school in September of 1918. The sisters arrived from Cherokee Iowa on August 29, 1918 and began school on September 3 with twenty-eight children.



From Fr. Urbanus after receiving word that the Servants of Mary agreed to come to staff a school at Holy Name: “Like the peaceful breaking of dawn upon a storm—routed right; like the placid quiet that comes to a wind-tossed sea; like the gentle, swift calm that follows in the wake of the furies of unharnessed elements, comes the relief: the Sisters, Servants of Mary of Cherokee, Iowa!”

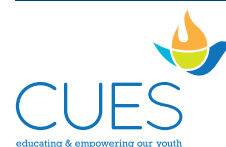
