Partnership Equals Success

The University of Nebraska–Omaha, School Psychology program, has worked with Holy Name students and teachers for almost 20 years. Holy Name alumni Dr. Joe Evans H65 introduced former principal Sofia Kock to UNO professor Dr. Lisa Kelly-Vance, and they began a rich collaboration. Every year UNO School Psychology graduate students work with Holy Name students during the school year and at the annual Summer Reading Program (now called Camp UNO).



During the school year the UNO students work with ten Holy Name students and their teachers to help improve learning. Approximately 150 students have increased their skills in reading, math, writing, homework completion or study skills through this program. UNO also provides a two-week summer reading program that is free to Holy Name students. This program has grown from four participants ten years ago to fifty participating this summer! Dr. Kelly-Vance and her graduate students give children the opportunity to enjoy reading activities and enhance their skills before starting the school year. This year the UNO Speech Language Pathology Program joined Camp UNO and facilitated fun learning activities for the younger children. For the past several years, participants received a t-shirt and a back pack filled with school supplies and lots of books! Both UNO and Holy Name students learn a lot from these collaborative experiences and report having a lot of fun. We are thankful for our partnership with UNO and many other community organizations that help further our students' education!

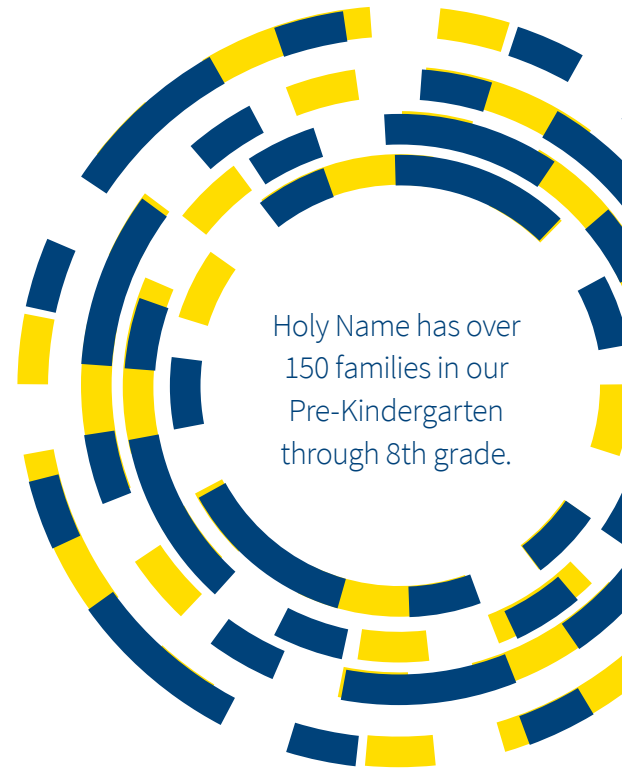

IRA CHARITABLE ROLL OVER

IRA Charitable Rollover

On December 18, 2015 the President signed the “Protecting Americans From Tax Hikes Act of 2015” into law. This law includes a permanent extension of the IRA Charitable Rollover. As in years past, the IRA Charitable Rollover allows individuals 70 ½ and older to donate up to \$100,000 in IRA assets to a qualified charitable organization. The Charitable IRA Rollover is tax-free and not included in a donor’s adjusted gross income.

Explanation of Provision

Individuals may make gifts to charity from traditional and Roth IRA accounts without any federal tax liability as long as the gifts are “qualified charitable distributions.” No charitable deduction may be taken by the owner, but distributions will qualify for all or part of an IRA owner’s Required Minimum Distribution.

Requirements for “qualified charitable distributions”

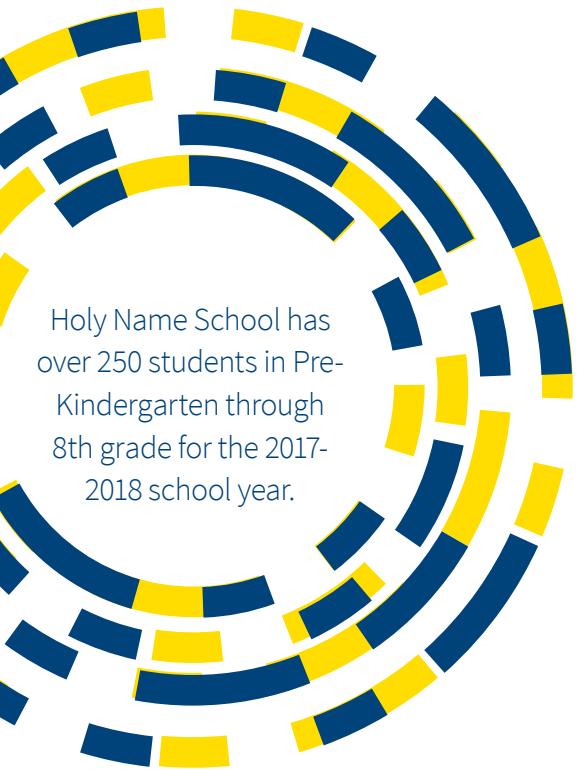
- Gifts are tax-free up to \$100,000 per year
- Gifts will qualify for all or part of your Required Minimum Distribution
- This provision is now permanent and is retroactive to January 1, 2015
- IRA holder must be age 70 ½ or older at the time of gift
- Gifts must be outright gifts to a charitable organization
- Distributions to donor-advised funds or support organizations are not permissible
- Distributions may only be made from traditional IRAs or Roth IRAs

Who benefits most from this Law?

There are several groups of individuals who will benefit from the charitable rollover.

1. People who normally don’t itemize their deductions can avoid taking the IRA distribution as income and send it directly to charity. This may reduce both their federal and state income tax liability.
2. Individuals whose IRA distributions increase their income to a level where 85% of their social security is taxed may want to make a qualified charitable distribution to reduce their income.
3. Individuals who give over 50% of their income to charity will not be constrained by the 30% and 50% limitations on charitable deductions on gifts from their IRAs.
4. Individuals in high income brackets who have large IRAs may have substantial income tax savings not otherwise available because of charitable deduction limitations. A qualified charitable distribution up to \$100,000 may have the triple benefit of reducing their taxable income, reducing the value in their IRA, and meeting their Required Minimum Distribution.

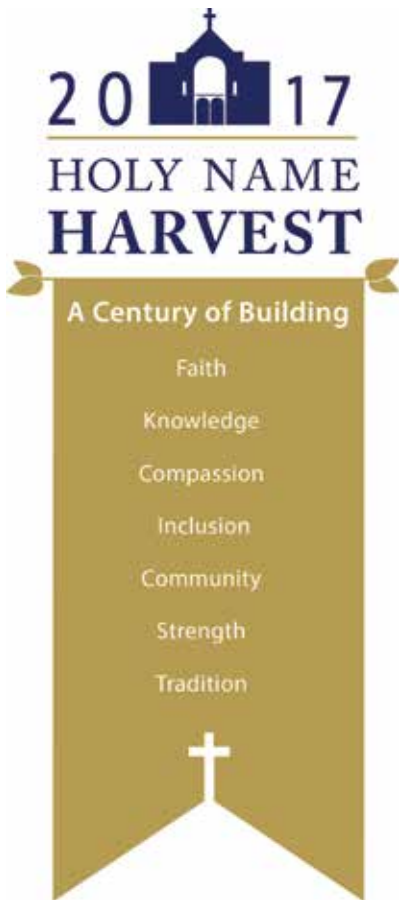
